FUNERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The funeral is a precious part of a minister's relationship with the people and a mediating influence involving the entire church and of the community. This outline of procedures is prepared with the hope that all concerned with the funeral may make of it an occasion of comfort and satisfying strength to the bereaved.

Ordinarily, in the case of members and those closely related to the church, the minister will have knowledge of the impending death and will sometimes be of assistance in the actual funeral arrangements (order of service, Scriptures, music to be used). They deem this a proper function of their total ministry.

Because the ministry to the bereaved is more than the actual funeral, the Pastor will only perform services for members of the church that are deceased. If it desired by the families that they would like the Pastor to perform the services for a non-member, this can be done at the discretion of the Pastor.

GENERAL ARRANGEMENTS

The church will provide use of the sanctuary, lower social area and kitchen for members. Be reminded however, that the family must provide food. The church will also have a committee ready to serve the members who return to the church for a re-pass. Careful planning must be made in advance to assure that the service and re-pass run smoothly.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Any honorarium to be given to the Pastor, musicians, etc., will be at the discretion of the family. Expenses connected with the use of church facilities will be as shown below. Non-members must supply their own bulletins, programs, paper products (paper plates, cups, napkins, etc.) and utensils.
